Urine Collection: Male



Patient Information - Microbiology

Your Doctor has requested a urine sample for examination. This test is very important to assess your health and will only give useful results if collected properly.

NOTE: It is important to collect your urine sample BEFORE starting any antibiotic medication.

Please use the following instructions to make your collection:

- 1. Label the specimen pottle provided with your name, date of birth and date of collection.
- 2. Wash your hands.
- 3. As normal bodily secretions can alter the result it is important you wash the area from which you pass urine. To do this, moisten a piece of toilet tissue with tap water. Pull back the foreskin of your penis (if necessary), and wipe away from the opening with the toilet tissue. Discard the tissue.
- 4. Remove the lid of the specimen pottle, being careful not to touch inside.
- 5. Pass a small amount of urine into the toilet, then, ensuring you are holding the jar from the outside, catch some urine in the pottle, mid-stream.
- 6. When you have filled the pottle to half full you have enough collected for the laboratory. (The remaining urine can be passed into the toilet).
- 7. Once finished, please screw the lid on the container **FIRMLY**, and wash your hands.
- 8. Take the sample to the laboratory on the same day as collection.
